'Cracked Ice' **HEUCHERELLA**

X Heucherella 'Cracked Ice'

Like a fractured ice block, this Foamy Bell has layers of intricate coloration and markings. An unusual hint of blue-green hides under the dark veining and the maple-like leaves are frosted in shades of silvery-pink in the cooler temperatures of spring and fall. Heucherella 'Cracked Ice' forms a compact, vigorous mound about 7" tall and 15" across with short spikes of white flowers in spring and summer.

USE

Container, mass planting, border

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Small white flowers spring and summer

GROWTH RATE

Moderate in sun, slow in shade

WATER

Regular water

SOIL

Any well-drained soil

FERTILIZE

Monthly in gardens; bi-monthly in containers

PRUNE

Remove dead leaves during growing season and old growth at end of floweing season (late summer); deadhead old blooms at stalk base to lengthen flowering season
