## DWARF LOROPETALUM

This petite beauty displays dark purple foliage year-round and bursts with lovely dark pink to red string clusters each spring. Purple Daydream™ is versatile, handling full sun to part shade, as well as offering drought tolerance and deer resistance. A compact loropetalum, it spreads nicely into a mound reaching 2-3 feet high by 3-4 feet wide.



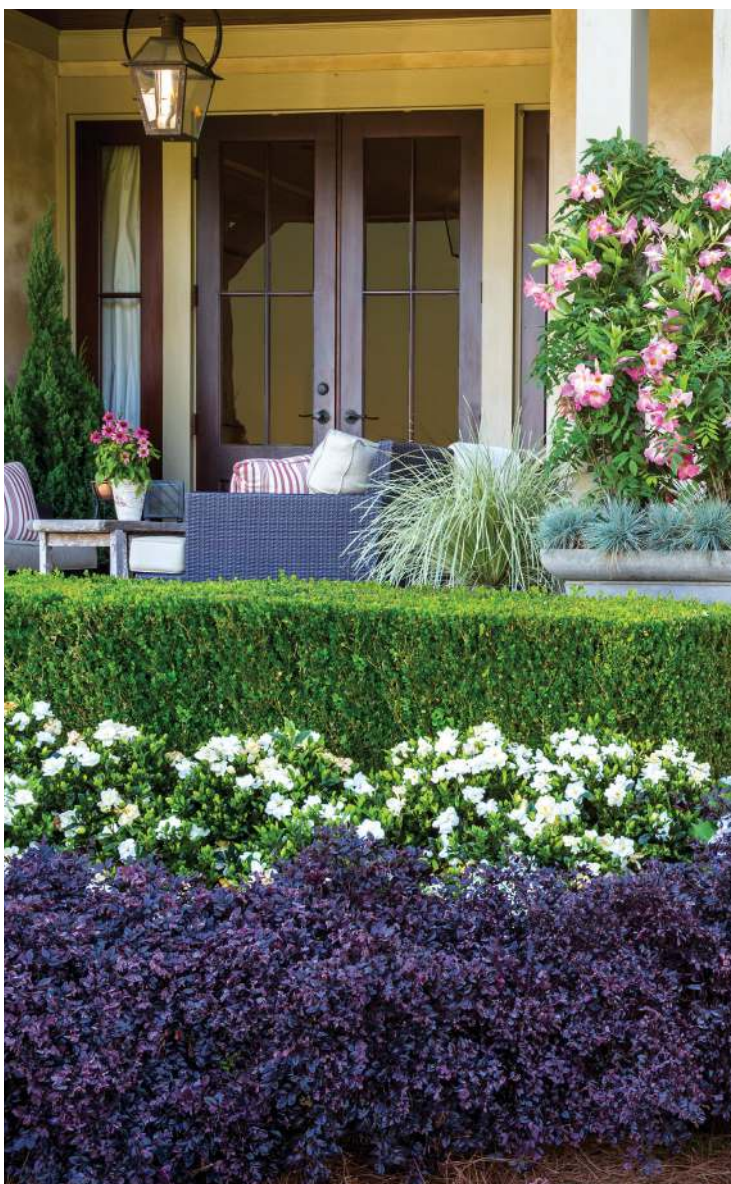

### PRUNE

Prune in early spring before first flush
